# **Fishers for Habitat Forum 2011**



Following the success of the <u>2009</u> and <u>2010</u> Forums the Fishers for Fish Habitat program, funded through Industry and Investment NSW and the NSW Recreational Fishing Trusts, will be hosting a 2011 Forum. Recreational fishers from across NSW are invited to attend the 2011 event, which for the first time will be hosted by a regional country centre west of the range.

#### The date

Friday 20 – Saturday 21 May 2011 (plus an optional 3rd day on Sunday 22 May for the inaugural Tamworth Carp Muster hosted by Namoi CMA).

#### The venue

The Pavilion, Nemingha, Tamworth NSW

Tamworth, the country music capital is located on the junction of the New England and Oxley highways making the city an easy 5 hour drive from Sydney, 7 hours from Brisbane or 3 and half hours from Port Macquarie.

Opportunities for freshwater fishing in the Tamworth region are vast with something to suit everyone's tastes: from wide rivers and small creeks to rocky headwaters and local impoundments.
