Fishers for Habitat Forum 2011



Following the success of the [2009](#) and [2010](#) Forums the Fishers for Fish Habitat program, funded through Industry and Investment NSW and the NSW Recreational Fishing Trusts, will be hosting a 2011 Forum. Recreational fishers from across NSW are invited to attend the 2011 event, which for the first time will be hosted by a regional country centre west of the range.

The date

Friday 20 – Saturday 21 May 2011 (plus an optional 3rd day on Sunday 22 May for the inaugural Tamworth Carp Muster hosted by Namoi CMA).

The venue

The Pavilion, Nemingha, Tamworth NSW

Tamworth, the country music capital is located on the junction of the New England and Oxley highways making the city an easy 5 hour drive from Sydney, 7 hours from Brisbane or 3 and half hours from Port Macquarie.

Opportunities for freshwater fishing in the Tamworth region are vast with something to suit everyone's tastes: from wide rivers and small creeks to rocky headwaters and local impoundments.

The free 2 day Forum will include formal presentations, poster sessions, interactive discussions and a field trip to check out habitat issues and local rehabilitation projects on the Peel River. More details about speakers and presentations will be provided as they are confirmed.
