# Fishers for Habitat Forum 2011 Its only 3 weeks away!!



The **Recreational Fishing Alliance of NSW**, the peak volunteer recreational fishing representative group is encouraging all anglers and community groups to come along to the third FREE Fishers for Fish Habitat Forum, on the 20-21<sup>st</sup> May in Tamworth which is funded by NSW recreational fishing licence fees.

The 2 day forum and field day will provide information on how much recreational fishing licence money is directed towards fish habitat works in NSW, along with ample opportunities for the public and anglers to network with each other and DPI – Conservation staff, who have a keen interest in fish habitat rehabilitation works. Following the success of the 2009 and 2010 Forums the Fishers for Fish Habitat program, funded through Industry and Investment NSW and the NSW Recreational Fishing Trusts, will be hosting a 2011 Forum. Recreational fishers from across NSW are invited to attend the 2011 event, which for the first time will be hosted by a regional country centre west of the range.

### The date

Friday 20 – Saturday 21 May 2011 (plus an optional 3rd day on Sunday 22 May for the inaugural Tamworth Carp Muster hosted by Namoi CMA).

# The venue

The Pavilion, Nemingha, Tamworth NSW

Tamworth, the country music capital is located on the junction of the New England and Oxley highways making the city an easy 5 hour drive from Sydney, 7 hours from Brisbane or 3 and half hours from Port Macquarie.

Opportunities for freshwater fishing in the Tamworth region are vast with something to suit everyone's tastes: from wide rivers and small creeks to rocky headwaters and local impoundments.
